

Henrietta's Church Starts International looking for technology donations to help overseas missions

Church Starts International (CSI), headquartered in Henrietta, has for over two decades been hard at work spreading the Word of Christ to many countries which were once part of the Soviet Union and to China by translating, publishing, teaching, training leadership, enlisting national volunteers, and establishing churchtype missions through weekly Bible clubs across the world.

Their latest efforts are centered around placing technology and other materials in the hands of those that need it most.

"As we near the end of 2016, I wanted to share some of the highlights of the past year and needs of the future," said Brother Bill Davis, President of the non-profit CSI. "During the year I have had the opportunity to spend many hours on Skype enlisting, supporting and encouraging our partners overseas. As much as possible

I am able to Skype with each of our seven translator/coordinators located in Romania, Moldova, Far Northern Siberia (Yakutia), Central Russia, Far Eastern Russia, Ukraine and China. During these Skype calls I have the joy of hearing fresh reports of ministries that are flourishing and people that are hearing the Gospel."

"During the year we have started a project of purchasing computers and printers to be used in the areas where our teams are working," Davis explained. "These computers and printers have been distributed to some remote areas where there is little contact with the outside world. They are used to download and print our CSI strategy and materials to be used by local pastors, committed laymen and dedicated women and youth who have been trained to use the materials to begin Bible clubs for children, Bible studies for adults and even to start

churches. The world is exciting, challenging and growing!

"Our need for 2017 is to enlist more team members," he continued, "purchase and place more computers and printers, and have more of our materials translated into major languages of the world as well as some of the 'heart languages' of the various people groups to whom we are able to minister. Each computer/printer costs approximately \$600. Perhaps as you plan your year-end giving you would pray about helping us meet this growing need! We also need funds to meet office expenses and provide training opportunities in more regions of the world. Training conferences that have been held in Moldova, Romania, and Russia have proven to be very effective, especially in equipping and mobilizing women for ministry in those areas, resulting in new mission points which can then become new

church starts. I pray that you will consider being a part of this great work for God.

"Thank you for your support in the past, for your prayers for me and the whole CSI family and for your interest in carrying the Gospel to the darkest corners of the world," Davis said.
